



Bristol Orienteering Klub (BOK) Night Score and Western Night League

Silk Wood, Westonbirt Arboretum
Map Reference ST856897, Postcode GL8 8QS

- Car Parking:** Visitor Centre car park. Follow signs for Westonbirt Arboretum. £1.00 car parking charge to be paid at registration.
- Map:** 1:10,000 scale. Printed double sided on A4 paper. Maps are not waterproof; please bring your own bag.
- Terrain:** Mix of landscaped forest and mixed forest, undergrowth in places.
- Course:** 60 minute score in the standard WNL format. Penalty: 1 point per 6 seconds late. Bonus: 1 point for every 6 seconds early if all controls found. The course will be split into two halves "Odd" and "Even". Each half has 13 controls, totaling 270 points. You may attempt the two halves in any order and can switch maps at any point. You will not have to clear one half before moving on to the next but once you have switched you cannot go back onto the first half. The point where you start each map will be determined by your first odd or even control punched. Four controls on each map form a 3.5km course of yellow (TD2/TD3) standard.
- Safety:** Whistles strongly recommended. Appropriate clothing should be worn. Competitors advised to carry a mobile telephone and spare lighting with them. The organiser's telephone number will be printed on the map.
- Timings:** Registration open from around 4.30pm. Starts from dusk for one hour. Courses close at 7.00 pm or one hour after last start, whichever is sooner.
- Entry Fee:** Seniors £4.00; Juniors/Students £1.00
- SI Card Hire:** Juniors free; Seniors £1.00; lost cards charged at £25.00
- Dogs:** Welcomed. Please keep your dog under control.
- Results:** Will be posted on BOK and Western Night League websites.

Leaving the arboretum, go straight across the A433 onto the one-way lane towards Westonbirt village. Continue down this lane (heading south) until you reach the B4040. Turn right, into Sherston, the pub is on your left after 200 yards.

'No whistle, no go' will be in force for all Juniors and strongly recommended for Seniors.
